



## *My Dear Child.*

I am your God, apart from me there is no other.<sup>[1]</sup> I am one God and Father of all creation,<sup>[2]</sup> I have always been here.<sup>[3]</sup> Before the mountains were made, before the universe was created, I am always your everlasting God.<sup>[4]</sup> You can rely on me for I am eternal<sup>[5]</sup> and I will always remain the same.<sup>[6]</sup>

I am the King eternal. I am immortal, and invisible<sup>[7]</sup>—no one has ever seen me,<sup>[8]</sup> but Jesus, my only-begotten Son,<sup>[9]</sup> has revealed me throughout history.<sup>[10]</sup> You can get to know me by knowing him,<sup>[11]</sup> for he continuously reveals me to my children.<sup>[12]</sup> As my children, you will one day see my face.<sup>[13]</sup> Blessed indeed are those of you who are pure in heart, for you will see me.<sup>[14]</sup> For this reason you should try your very hardest to live peacefully with everyone and to be holy; for without holiness no one will see me.<sup>[15]</sup>

I am the living God;<sup>[16]</sup> I have feelings, and I have the power to do whatever pleases me.<sup>[17]</sup> I am a person with self-consciousness, for I am who I am.<sup>[18]</sup> I stand alone—there is no one who rivals me,<sup>[19]</sup> no one can measure my thoughts<sup>[20]</sup> and no one on earth who completely understands me,<sup>[21]</sup> for I am incomparable to anyone or anything you may know.<sup>[22]</sup> But it is my pleasure to explain the mystery of my desires,<sup>[23]</sup> for I am compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, the One who holds love in all abundance.<sup>[24]</sup>

Because of my compassion I made sure that my wonders would be remembered throughout history,<sup>[25]</sup> I inspired books to be written for future ages, for generations not yet created<sup>[26]</sup> and from the most ancient of times I have made known my purpose and what will happen in the end.<sup>[27]</sup>

I have a panoramic view of time. Do not forget that, for me, eternity is one everlasting present and a day is like a thousand years;<sup>[28]</sup> for me, a thousand years are like a day that has just passed.<sup>[29]</sup> Therefore, do not worry.<sup>[30]</sup> My eyes are everywhere, keeping watch over the wicked and the good,<sup>[31]</sup> and I have seen your tears.<sup>[32]</sup> I have seen when you are miserable and I have heard your crying; I am concerned about your suffering.<sup>[33]</sup> My heart has been filled with pain about your condition from the beginning,<sup>[34]</sup> for I can see you always.<sup>[35]</sup>

I know what is essential for your daily lives.<sup>[36]</sup> Therefore, do not be overly concerned for tomorrow, for each day has its own share of difficulties.<sup>[37]</sup> Simply look for me and my rule on earth and your daily needs will be provided for.<sup>[38]</sup>

I do not live in any one particular place for I am Spirit—where I am, there is freedom.<sup>[39]</sup> The whole universe cannot contain me;<sup>[40]</sup> I fill both heaven and earth and<sup>[41]</sup> this is why I can be your perfect refuge and strength, for I am always present to help you.<sup>[42]</sup> If you truly call out to me, you will see that I am near you.<sup>[43]</sup> Indeed, each time you pray, I am closer to you than you can imagine.<sup>[44]</sup>

Nothing in all creation is hidden from my sight.<sup>[45]</sup> I know you better than you know yourself,<sup>[46]</sup> for I created the hearts of every person and I consider everything you do.<sup>[47]</sup> I see all your ways and I examine every path you choose to take.<sup>[48]</sup>

Both my Son—the Christ—and our Holy Spirit have been with me from all eternity and they too are God.<sup>[49]</sup> We know each other intimately and perfectly; indeed, you cannot come to know me unless my Son reveals me to you. No one completely knows the Son except his Father,<sup>[50]</sup> and my Holy Spirit knows the deepest parts of me.<sup>[51]</sup> I too know the mind of the Spirit, for the Spirit tells me everything, even the needs and desires of all my children.<sup>[52]</sup>

I reveal myself to you by my Spirit, He searches everything—from the universe to my own deepest thoughts.<sup>[53]</sup> This is how it should be, for who else knows your thoughts except your own self, your own spirit within you?<sup>[54]</sup>

Be strengthened for I am all-powerful, able to do anything I desire;<sup>[55]</sup> no plan of mine can be thwarted.<sup>[56]</sup> For me, all things are possible.<sup>[57]</sup> Remember, it is I who made the entire universe, there is nothing too difficult for me to do.<sup>[58]</sup> But some things are contrary to my nature: my eyes are too pure to gaze on evil and I cannot tolerate wrongdoing;<sup>[59]</sup> I cannot deny myself either, so I will always be faithful to you;<sup>[60]</sup> I do not tempt anyone with evil and I, myself, cannot be tempted by evil;<sup>[61]</sup> also, I cannot lie, so you can be sure that my promises to you are true from before the beginning of time.<sup>[62]</sup>

You can therefore put your trust in me, because it is impossible for me to lie.<sup>[63]</sup> You can trust in me forever,<sup>[64]</sup> trust in me with all your heart—and do not rely on your own understanding, but acknowledge me in everything you do, and I will guide you throughout your life.<sup>[65]</sup>

You were made in my image,<sup>[66]</sup> and I have sustained you since your birth.<sup>[67]</sup> You exist, live and move within me<sup>[68]</sup> and even to your old age, when your hair has

become grey, I will still be the One who sustains you; I have made you and I will always carry you, and rescue you.<sup>[69]</sup> Therefore, do not worry but entrust your cares to me—I will support you.<sup>[70]</sup> I care for you deeply; leave all your troubles with me.<sup>[71]</sup>

You can be sure that I will not change; I, your Father, do not change.<sup>[72]</sup> My love has always been with my children, from everlasting to everlasting.<sup>[73]</sup> My character remains the same and my years will never end.<sup>[74]</sup> Although the heavens will be changed like a piece of clothing, like a robe I shall one day roll them up, I will forever remain the same true God.<sup>[75]</sup>

Be therefore strengthened in your faith; I have the power to fulfil all my promises to you.<sup>[76]</sup> No matter how many promises I have made throughout history and before, I want you to see that they are all 'Yes' in my Son Jesus.<sup>[77]</sup> I have kept my promises because I am righteous;<sup>[78]</sup> righteousness and justice are my throne's foundations, love and faithfulness is present wherever I am.<sup>[79]</sup>

I am good,<sup>[80]</sup> I am just,<sup>[81]</sup> I am light.<sup>[82]</sup> Look to me and I will give you your daily needs,<sup>[83]</sup> for the desires of every living creature are satisfied from my hand.<sup>[84]</sup>

I long for you.<sup>[85]</sup> Discover what pleases me and live as a child of light.<sup>[86]</sup> Turn to me and be saved.<sup>[87]</sup> If you love my Son Jesus, we will come and make our home with you<sup>[88]</sup> Because you will be my child, I will send the very Spirit of my Son into your heart<sup>[89]</sup> and, even if you have times of faithlessness, I will remain faithful for I cannot disown myself.<sup>[90]</sup> I will forever be a Father to you and you will be my child,<sup>[91]</sup> no one has the power to snatch you away from me.<sup>[92]</sup>
